Items accepted: Complete desktop computer, CRT computer monitors, LCD flat-panel monitors, Terminals/CPU's, Televisions, Printers, scanners, fax machines, printer/fax machines, desktop copy machines, stereos, radios, VCR, & DVD Players, microwaves, battery backups, cell phones, PDA, MP3, personal CD players, household batteries (AAA, AA, etc.), compact fluorescent lamps, fluorescent tubes, Styrofoam & empty printer toner & ink cartridges.



Items not accepted: Broken televisions, broken monitors, and ink toners and cartridges that an individual has refilled. Foam rubber.

Charges for items:

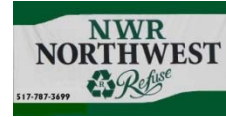
- 1 Fluorescent bulbs-\$.50 each
- 2 CRT style computer monitors – **First is free**, then \$3 each
- 3 CRT style televisions – **First TV free**. After first, up to 13" = \$5 each, Over 19" = \$10 each
- 4 Printers & empty ink cartridges – no charge

Items accepted: *Brush* – brush must not exceed 3 feet in length with a maximum diameter of a human wrist. Material must be bundled together and tied or in biodegradable paper compost bags. The customer is responsible for unloading. *Grass clippings & leaves* in biodegradable paper compost bags.  
Items not accepted: Brush that exceeds the maximum dimensions or brought in plastic bags, materials that are not bundled or bagged properly, and root balls.

Items accepted: All clothing, shoes, household items, toys, furniture, & electronics. Items must be clean and resalable.  
Items not accepted: Anything that does not work, is broken or dirty, or not in usable condition.

**Tires/LP Tanks/Car Batteries/Motor Oil** collected by HUCO Recycling/Kurpinski (*Charge-See below*)
